

CAMPUS ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS

The University of Denver requires all conference attendees and staff to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or provide proof of a negative test prior to arrival on campus.

Individuals aged 12+ are considered fully vaccinated after receiving primary dose(s) plus booster. Individuals aged 8-11 are currently considered fully vaccinated after receiving their primary dose.

If a conference guest is not vaccinated, proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR or laboratory antigen test record will be accepted. The test must be taken no earlier than 72-hours prior to check-in on campus.

Proof of vaccination status **or** negative test result must be uploaded to <u>CrowdPass</u> prior to campus arrival.

CrowdPass is a HIPPA-compliant platform and will independently verify all records.

How to Upload Records:

- 1. Scan the QR Code with your cellphone camera to open the linked website or visit the URL.
- 2. Check that the information and dates match the event you are attending.
- 3. Click **Register**, then sign-up using your email.
- 4. Select Complete the Health Form.
- 5. Fill out the survey and either upload proof of vaccination or a negative test result. If you are submitting proof of vaccination, you may do so at your earliest convenience. Negative test submissions will only be accepted within 72-hours prior to campus arrival. Any earlier test dates and/or rapid test results will be denied.
- 6. You will receive email confirmation on your status within 24 hours. If access is denied, please check that you are fully vaccinated according to DU policy or that your negative test fits within the time requirements. If your records align with the University of Denver requirements, please reach out to your conference contact for more information.
